

(Often called the Chinese linking rings, this may be a genuine oriental feat; its origins are vague, but it was first introduced to western audiences by a touring troupe of Chinese performers. Early performers used as many as a dozen rings in their routines; that of David P. Abbott. In the 1950's Dai Vernon released his Symphony of the Rings routine, which used only six rings; a few years prior, in 1948, Billy McComb had described his five-ring routine in *Abracadabra* magazine.

Harmony had four competitors from left to right Richard Wibberley, Frank Smith, George Kechichian and Benjamin Hermans.




1st Place winner was Frank Smith.
